The Y6 parent/teacher consultations will be on the 9<sup>th</sup> of July, when your child will present their best learning from this year.

The Leavers' ceremony will be on the 19th of July (timings to be announced).

# Learning Values this Term: Meaning Makers: Empathy and Responsibility

Our history topic is 'Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age'. We will focus on these areas:

**Culture** – What is the difference between Skara Brae and an Iron Age hill fort? Stories – What were the Celts like?

**Legacies** – What kinds of evidence are there for pre-history? **Individuals** – How did humans survive in the Stone Age?

Belief - Who built Stonehenge?

Once our focus areas are finished, we will learn about the Iron Age game of knuckle-bone Jack and compare the Ages with other History topics we have learnt in LKS2 and KS1.



### <u>English</u>



This term we will continue to read "The Final Year" by Matt Goodfellow. If your child enjoys this book then they might also like "Skellig" by David Almond or another verse novel like "The Way of Dog" by Zana Frallion.

The main focus will be on writing. we will be producing a couple of pieces of writing, as we build our writing portfolio before I make my teacher assessments of writing at the end of June.

In <u>Maths</u> this half term, we will focus on applying our maths knowledge to solving problems and puzzles.

In the <u>Science</u> lessons this term we will learn about variation and adaptations and then Fossils.



**<u>PE</u>** will take place on Monday afternoons and Wednesday mornings. Children are asked to come into school in their PE kits on those days.

**Spanish:** For the final half term of Key Stage 2 languages for Year 6, we will learn some basic Spanish in preparation for the language options at secondary school.

Music: We will be learning the numbers and choreography for our end of year performance

#### HOME LEARNING:

- Home-learning Sheets: will come out next week
- <u>Book exchange:</u> Children should have a book at school and a book to take home. They should bring their book back and exchange from the class library when finished. A reading record book will be provided which Year 6 should be encouraged to fill in with phrases and sentences that they have 'magpied' from their reading, to use in their own writing. ALL library books will need to be returned to school before July.
- **Summer term project:** Gallery on the 25<sup>th</sup> June.
