## The Curriculum

# <u>English</u>

This half term in English, we will continue reading our class book, the Nothing to See Here Hotel. As we read through the book together, we will work on areas of the writing curriculum.

## <u>Maths</u>

We will be beginning the half term by finishing off our topic on money. Then we will move onto looking at time, statistics, and finally, shape.

## <u>Science</u>

This half term in science we will be looking at forces and magnets. We will look at the different forces affecting a toy car rolling down a ramp. Then, we will investigate which materials are magnetic.

# Computing

In computing, we will be learning about simulations, then we will move on to creating our own presentations.

### <u>History</u>

We will continue our history topic on the Mayans this half term. The children will continue to investigate the following questions:

- What were Mayan cities and architecture like?
- Who are the Maya?
- What are the 'systems' used by the Maya?
- Who was Pakal the Great?
- What did the ancient Maya believe in?

# <u>P.E</u>.

Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Wednesday. Children should come to school in their outdoor PE kit on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings and will remain in it all day. Please check the school website if you require clarification of the correct PE kit.

# <u>Art</u>

This half term in art we will be looking at the work of Pablo Picasso. We will look at the style of cubism, then paint our own portraits in this style.
