Curriculum Newsletter - Autumn 2





The Curriculum

English

This half term in English we will be reading Arthur and the Golden Rope. We will be working on our prediction and comprehension skills and then looking at areas of the writing curriculum.



Maths

This half term in maths, we will be continuing our work on addition and subtraction before moving on to multiplication and division.

Science

We will finish our unit on diet and nutrition, then we will move on to looking at different rocks and their properties.



Computing

In computing, we will be using Scratch to create an animation. Scratch is a visual, block-based programming software.

We will be learning all the skills needed to design and make our own party bags! We will conduct some product research and experiment with different sewing techniques, then we will design and create our own product.
