

The Curriculum

English

This half term in English we will be reading Emily Brown and the Elephant Emergency. We will be working on our prediction and comprehension skills, whilst revisiting areas of the writing curriculum covered in year 1.



Maths

We will be focussing on place value of numbers up to 100 at the beginning of this half term, then we will move on to looking at addition and subtraction.

Science

We will start looking at animal groups in science. The children will learn the features of mammals, birds, reptiles, fish and amphibians and we will investigate their needs for survival.

Computing

In computing, we will initially focus on online safety, looking at ways we can stay safe online.

Geography

This term, Year 1 and 2 will learn about Africa. They will be focusing on the following questions:



- What are the seven continents and five oceans?
- Why is it hot in Africa?
- What animals would you see in Africa?
- How would my life differ if I lived in Africa?

We have arranged to take the children to Yorkshire Wildlife Park on **Thursday 2nd October** as part of this topic. You will receive a separate letter about this trip next week, but if you would like to help on the trip, please let me or Miss Alston know.

P.E.

Our P.E. days are **Monday** (forest school) and **Wednesday** and will be held outside until the weather becomes colder. Children should come to school in their outdoor PE kit on Wednesday

mornings and will remain in it all day. Please check the school website if you require clarification of the correct PE kit.
