The Curriculum

English


This half term we will be spending some time in the wizarding world as we look at our new text, Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them. We will be exploring non-fiction style writing, how to write descriptively using conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions before writing our own non-chronological report.



Maths

In Maths, we will be looking at multiplication and division in more detail. The children will be spending time looking at multiplying and dividing by 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12 as well as consolidating their previous

facts. The children have now received their Times Table booklets and have begun working towards their bronze, silver and gold badges. As always, please encourage the children to keep their times table facts fresh by practicing on TT Rockstars. They should all have a username and password. Please let me know if they need a reminder.



Science

In Science we will then be looking at states of matter and finding out about solids, liquids and gases. The children will explore how materials can change state and investigate the processes of melting, freezing, evaporation and condensation.

History

We are continuing our history topic about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. The children loved finding out about Anglo-Saxon and Viking life and where the Vikings originally came from, before getting their fearsome reputation as vicious raiders! We will be starting to look at Vikings mythology and their beliefs over the coming weeks.



Computing

We will be diving in to a new topic in computing and learning how to make our very own Quiz eBooks.

DT

In DT we will be looking at how we can design, prepare and evaluate making healthy food. We will be thinking about the principles of a healthy, balanced diet as well researching and investigating the best recipe we can find!

P.E.

Our P.E. days are Monday and Thursday. This half term the children will be developing their throwing and catching skills through dodgeball and enjoying the wonders of dance! Children should come to school in their outdoor PE kit on Monday and Thursday mornings and will remain in it all day.
